author and director

Alfredo Sanzol studied Scene Direction in the “Real Escuela Superior de Arte Dramático” and then graduated in Law at the Navarra University.

He has been directing theatre since 1999, when he premiered *Como los griegos*, by Steven Berkoff in RESAD’s “aula 4.11”, which then seasoned at the “Sala Galileo”. During the next two years, he co-wrote and directed *Carrusel palace* and wrote and directed *Cous cous y churros* with “Producciones del Callao”. They were shown in the “Sala Triángulo” and in “La Cuarta Pared” respectively.

From 2002 to 2005, he wrote and directed several street plays for the *València Escena Oberta* festival, and the sitcom *Living Lavapiés* for Telemadrid. After that, he has released a great variety of plays, such as *Risas y destrucción* in 2006 with “Producciones del Callao” premiered in “La Cuarta Pared”, *Sí, pero no lo soy* in 2008 with “Centro Dramático Nacional” premiered in the “Princesa” hall from the María Guerrero Theatre, and *La Cabeza del Bautista* by Valle Inclán with “Centro Dramático Nacional” and premiered in the Valle Inclán Theatre.

In the last eight years he has written and directed seven plays and directed another three: *Días estupendos* and *Delicadas* in 2010, *En la luna* in 2011, *La importancia de llamarse Ernesto* by Oscar Wilde and *Aventura!* in 2012, *Esperando a Godot* by Samuel Beckett in 2013, *La calma magica* in 2014, *Edipo Rey* by Sófocles in 2015, *La respiración* in 2016



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and *La ternura* in 2017. For these, he collaborated with production companies such as LAZONA, “Centro Dramático Nacional”, “T de Teatre”, “Teatro de la Abadía”, “Teatre Liliubre”, “Teatro Gayarre de Pamplona” and “Tanttaka”, and premiered in many theatres and festivals, such as “Teatro Poliorama” in Barcelona during the Grec Festival, “Teatro de la Abadía”, “Teatro Fernando Fernán Gómez” or “Los Teatros del Canal”. Now, in 2018, he will launch his last creation, *La valentía*, from which he is author and director.

In the year 2015 he founded, together with Miguel de Arco and Andres Lima, “Teatro de la Ciudad”, designed to opt for the investigation, reflection, production and exhibition of contemporary theatre. The project “Teatro de la Ciudad”, in addition to showing the own productions of these authors, was also born with the goal of opening its doors to other contemporary creators and to the new values of the theatrical scene.

Moreover, Alfredo Sanzol has also taught several courses and workshops at “La Casa de América”, “La Casa Encendida”, the Bogota National Theatre, “Matadero-Madrid”, “Sala Beckett”, the Navarra School of Theatre, the Authors General Society “SGAE”, the “Teatro Clásico de Olite” festival, the “ECAM” (Cinema school), “Centro Dramático Nacional”, “Juneda inCursió” and “Teatro de la Abadía/Teatro de la Ciudad”. In 2014 he directed the II Theatrical Writing Laboratory of the SGAE Foundation.

During all these years he has been awarded four MAX awards for Best Author: in 2011 for *Delicadas*, in 2012 for *Días estupendos*, in 2013 for *En la luna* and in 2017 for *La respiración*. In addition to that, he also received the “Ceres” to Best Author 2012 for *En la luna*, and the MAX Award for Best Show in 2013, as well as the Dramatic Literature National Award in 2017 for *La respiración*.



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SYnopsis

In The courage, a couple of sisters, Guada and Trini, have inherited the family home in which they spent their summers in the countryside. They both love the house, but it has a small problem: five meters away from the entrance door there is a motorway. In spite of that, Guada wants to keep it and has decided to stay and spend the winter there, but Trini is worried about her sister's obsession for the house and wants to take her out of there at all cost.

ABOUT THE PLAY


Beauty is so big that it doesn't fit in our hearts when it visits us, and that makes us suffer, because we wish we could turn wider in order to make space for it. We think that we can maybe fit it by discarding memories and traces of scattered pain, or ugliness that is bolted to our brain, but we see that that's impossible because they are already a part of us. Only then we realize our last chance is to transform in order to grow. We grow as much as we can so that beauty will have space, will pass and will stay, but when our soul's joints and muscles grow, they start suffering. Then, what we thought was solid begins to shatter, what we considered fix suddenly staggers, and we start to feel fear. It is at that point that we are left with the only possibility of shyly calling the sole strength that will be able to help us continue: courage.

Graduate in Hispanic Philology, doctorate in Theatre Theory and Practice and trained as an actor by the Madrid “Teatro de Cámara”, he has been part of La Abadía’s cast since the year 2000, when he participated in *El Mercader de Venecia* and *El Rey Lear*, directed by H. Heyme and in *Mesías* and *El Rey se muere* under José Luis Gómez’s orders. Two seasons ago, he was directed by Aladro in *La ilusión de Kushner / Corneille*, also at La Abadía.

He balances his work at “La Abadía” with numerous projects in different companies: shows like *La defensa*, directed by Domingo Ortega, *La Vuelta al mundo*, directed by David Ojeda, and *Los desastres del amor*, by Nieves Olcoz, in the “Transatlantic Project” (Spain- Chile), or *El maleficio de la mariposa*, directed by D. Ortega, *La noche de los asesinos*, by Elena Espinosa and *Trabajos de amor perdidos*, under D. Ortega’s direction with the “Blenamiboa” company, from which he is co-founder. Moreover, he has worked with “El Armadillo” company, from which he is also co-founder, in *Ensalada de bandidos*, *Haemorroisa* and *Autorretrato doble*, all of them directed by Óscar G. Villegas; with the “Invenciones Cósmicas” company in *Cajas*, *Inmaduros para siempre*, directed by Luca Aprea, and *Mañana voy yo difícil*, directed by Ignacio Calvache for the “Contando Hormigas” company. He is part of the “Ophelia” crew, a theatre and other arts magazine, and has worked as a teacher at the “Aula de Estudios Escénicos” from the University of Alcalá de Henares, and as an assistant director at the “Théâtre du Mouvement” in Paris.

As a director, he has worked in *Decapitation* by Marco A. de la Parra with the “Blenamiboa” company, and he was the coordinator of the collective creations “Velatororio-variettes” of *Rosa de los labios tristes* and *Concha in the sky with diamonds*.

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PRODUCTION COMPANY: LAZONA

Created in 2003, LAZONA's intention has always been to develop projects of all genres, both commercially fruitful and of cultural or artistic importance. This means a combination of consolidated talent with emerging talent.

In 2004 it premiered *El otro lado de la cama* directed by Josep María Mestres. This work was followed by productions such as Gá-Gá (winner of two Max awards) and *J'arrive*, by choreographer Marta Carrasco, *El sueño de una noche de verano*, directed by Tamzin Townsend, with musical direction by Antonio Carmona, *Cyrano de Bergerac*, by John Strassberg, and *Baraka*, directed by Jo-Sep Maria Mestres.

Since 2008 it has premiered productions like *¿Estás ahí?*, *Piedras en los bolsillos*, *Días estupendos*, written and directed by Alfredo Sanzol, *Tartufo*, *El manual de la buena esposa*, *Las criadas* or *Locos por el té*.

In 2015 it premiered *La piedra oscura*, directed by Pablo Messiez, which has received five Max Awards (Best theater show, Best theatrical authorship, Best stage direction, Best stage design and Best lighting design), *Más apellidos vascos*, directed by Gabriel Olivares, and *Tamaño familiar*, directed by Quino Falero.

In 2015, Teatro de la Ciudad was created as the union of the Kamikaze, Siamese and LAZONA producing companies, and the directors Alfredo Sanzol, Miguel del Arco and Andrés Lima. An ambitious project that, after conducting workshops and meetings, culminated in the tragedies *Antígona*, *Medea* and *Edipo Rey* and whose work has been recog-



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nized with the Max Award for the Best Private Production of Performing Arts. In 2017 the project continues with *Sueño*, by Andrés Lima, and *La ternura*, by Alfredo Sanzol.

That same year it created LAZONAKUBIK, an innovative space that promotes research projects and supports playwrights, dramatists, directors and emerging directors. The projects developed within it have been *Hard Candy*, with Julián Fuentes, *Fortune Cookie*, with Carlota Ferrer, *Nora*, with Lucía Miranda, and *Beautiful Beach*, with Antonio Ruz.

In 2016 it premiered at La Abadía Theater *La respiración*, written and directed by Alfredo Sanzol (Max Award for Best theatrical author and Best Leading actress) *Miguel de Molina al desnudo*, by Ángel Ruiz (Max Award for Best Leading Actor), and *Cáscaras vacías*, by the directors Magda Labarga and Laila Ripoll.

In March of the same year, it presented the I Draft of Dramaturgies in order to disseminate texts that haven't been premiered among the professionals of the scene. In May / June 2017, it organized the first Dramaturgy Tournament at the Spanish Theatre in Madrid.



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
